

Luther Clapp House

12323 Watertown Plank Road

This house was built in 1856 for one of Wauwatosa's pioneer clergymen, the Rev. Luther Clapp. The parlor served as a classroom for the community's first high school, founded by the Rev. and Mrs. Clapp. The house was built facing south on a two-acre lot at the northeast corner of what are now Wauwatosa and Milwaukee Avenues. It was moved to its present site in 1976 to allow for the expansion of Wauwatosa East High School.
