MAINTAIN NATIONAL ACCREDITATION



Continued development of continuous quality improvement culture through department-wide LEAN projects



Submitted required annual report to the Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB)



Conducted staff and Board of Health led strategic planning; completed 2018-2022 WHD Strategic Plan

COMMUNITY HEALTH



Hosted meeting with over 30 community partners to discuss emerging health needs



Completed 2018-2022 Community Health Assessment and Improvement Plan



Participated on over 15 commissions, committees and groups

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING



Increased 2-Year Old Immunization Rates to 85% in 2017 from 78% in 2015



Completed 411 investigations to stop the spread of disease throughout Wauwatosa



Saw over 300 clients at adult health clinics

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH



Conducted 573 inspections (food, retail, temporary establishments and schools)



Followed up on 65 animal bites, resulting in 33 quarantine orders and 11 specimen sent for rabies testing



Implemented new database for more efficient inspection and licensing
